3. DESCRIPTION

AIM 382 Solvent-Free Pedestal Adhesive is specially formulated to bond metal pedestals to concrete during the fabrication process of raised computer floors. Designed for the professionals, featuring a fast tack, high initial strength film in addition to the ease of application.

Coverage

150-200 4" pedestals per gallon.

Subfloor Preparation

Floor must be clean, smooth, dry and free of any foreign matter that would interfere with a good bond. If concrete has been sealed, spot check to determine if sealer should be scuffed before attaching pedestal. Pedestals should also be free of oily residue. For best results, the area to be installed, adhesive and pedestals should be conditioned at 70°F (21°F) with a minimum relative humidity of 65% for at lease 24 hours before and after installation. Moisture Test – All concrete floors should be tested for moisture emission rate by utilizing anhydrous calcium chloride moisture test kit. (Available from installation supplies and accessories dealers.) Follow kit manufacturer's instructions precisely to determine moisture emissions.

Shelf Life

Maximum 1 year from date of manufacture in properly stored, unopened plastic package.

Limitations

- · For interior use only.
- Not for use in the presence of moisture or high alkalinity (pH greater than 9).
- Protect from freezing. Adhesive is freeze/thaw stable 5 cycles at 10°F. Prolonged low temperatures or multiple freeze/thaw cycles should be avoided.
- Keep container sealed when not in use.
- Do not use when the substrate temperature is below 40°F (4.4°C) or above 100°F (38°C).
- · Always store in an upright position.

5. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Application

- If concrete has been sealed, spot check to determine if sealer should be scuffed before applying the adhesive. Pedestals should also be free of any oily residue.
- 2. Dip pedestal base into adhesive. Butt and rotate an uncoated pedestal base against the coated one until both pedestal bases are equally coated. Position pedestals on subfloor
- 3. The adhesive should be applied so that the entire pedestal surface to be adhered is AIM 382 Solvent-Free Pedestal Adhesive completely covered. No more than ¼" bead of adhesive should exude around the base perimeter of the pedestal when positioned against the subfloor. Excess adhesive will retard final set time.
- 4. It is the sole responsibility of the installer to determine the suitability and compatibility of the AIM 382 for the user's intended use.

Clean-up

Wet adhesive may be removed with soap and water. Cured adhesive must be removed mechanically.
